

Touch Control for Scopia XT Series Systems



Avaya Scopia[®] Control is an Apple iPad application for control of Scopia XT series video conferencing room, telepresence, and executive desktop systems. Most end-users in business are familiar and comfortable with tablet computing and using the Apple iPad tablet in a variety of business environments. Scopia Control for the Apple iPad device brings that familiarity to roombased video conferencing to help dramatically reduce the learning curve and increase the effectiveness and adoption of video conferencing systems.

First time users can initiate calls, control their systems, and moderate meetings without any training or introduction. The integrated conference room calendar and enterprise directory makes it easy to join meetings and invite others. Video system control and meeting moderation are simple through the Apple iPad multi-touch user interface. Users can view presentations, spreadsheets, documents, and images with standards-based H.239 data collaboration, and can also review previously shared materials without interrupting the presenter using the Avaya unique advanced data collaboration / slider function.

Easily Join Meetings

Join a meeting from the integrated room calendar with a single click. Through the intuitive touch screen interface of the Apple iPad device, place calls, access your corporate directory, and previous calls with no instructions required.

Control Scopia[®] Room Systems

Select video sources, control local and remote PTZ cameras via far end camera control, start the presentation, and mute the Scopia® XT system microphone for privacy through the elegant Apple iPad touch screen.

Moderate Video Meetings

Manage your conference through the participants list, mute the microphone, stop the camera, or even disconnect other attendees. Easily invite other meeting participants from your corporate directory. Change the video layout and number of videos each participant views. Start or pause recording or streaming, lock the conference, extend the meeting time, or end the entire conference.

View Advanced Data Collaboration

View presentations, spreadsheets, documents, and images shared in a video conference with H.239 interoperable data collaboration. Participants can immediately review previously shared materials and catch up if they arrived late to a meeting, or spend additional time on critical points in material presented, all without interrupting the presenter.

Very Cost-Effective

Scopia Control runs on the Apple iPad tablet, leveraging its multi-touch user interface, large screen, and high resolution graphics. Utilizing the Apple iPad tablet provides a cost-effective control application that doesn't require an expensive, proprietary device. The Scopia Control app is available for free download from the Apple App Store, and will connect to any Scopia XT Series system with the appropriate license installed.

Meeting Initiation

Calling

- Call by IP address, E.164, H.323 name (alias) or SIP URI
- Call any user or any endpoint from the directory (local XT endpoint and corporate directory¹)
- Corporate¹ and local directory access through a simple search-based interface
- Recent calls for repeat dialing

• Join meetings from integrated conference room calendar¹

Endpoint Control Features

Audio/Video

- Video source selection
- PTZ (pan, tilt, zoom) of main and secondary cameras
- Set and select camera presets

Meeting Control

Moderation

- View the list of participants connected
- Mute the microphones of participants
- Stop the camera of any participant
- Disconnect a participant

Control

- Start/stop meeting recording
- Start/stop meeting streaming with Scopia® Content Center
- Lock the meeting (on external Scopia[®] Elite MCU) so that no one else can join
- Terminate the meeting and disconnect everyone (on external Scopia Elite MCU)

Video Layout

- Set the layout of a participant to automatic, where the video layout auto-adjusts when attendees join or leave
- Choose the number of videos desired in a layout

• Rearrange the screen layout for each individual participant

Note regarding video layouts: external Scopia Elite conferences have per individual participant video layout control; Scopia XT series endpoint built-in MCU conferences have per conference video layout control.

Inviting Additional Participants

- Invite by IP address, E.164, H.323 name (alias) or SIP URI
- Invite a phone by its number
- Invite any user or any endpoint from the directory (local XT endpoint and corporate directory¹)
- Corporate directory access through a simple search based interface¹
- Recent calls for repeat dialing

Data Collaboration

- Present shared content from a PC connected to a Scopia XT series endpoint in a video conference
- Display shared content locally
- View presentations, spreadsheets, documents and images

- Review previously presented materials (requires Scopia® Desktop server)
- Interoperable with H.239 (H.323) and BFCP (SIP) video conferencing data collaboration

Minimum Requirements

- All hardware versions of Apple iPad and iPad Mini
- iOS 5.1 minimum
- Device must be connected to a network, which can reach the target Avaya Scopia XT series system
